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ABOUT YOUR HYRAX

This appliance is cemented in for about 6 months. At first you will have more saliva and your speech will be affected. That will soon go away.

Some steps to help you:

- 1. We suggest ibuprofen (advil, motrin) for any discomfort that may occur.
- 2. Warm salt water rinses daily should keep food from getting caught in the appliance.
- 3. The appliance needs to be activated either by a parent or by yourself (if able to). This needs to be done *ONCE A DAY EVERY DAY* either in the *AM* or *PM*.
- 4. We will give you a key and demonstrate. The key is placed in the hole in the center of appliance. You will then push the key towards the back of the mouth. You will *NOT* be done until you see another hole appear. Then you may gently remove key. Always double check that you can see the next hole.
- 5. You may develop a space between your two front teeth. *DO NOT WORRY!* We need that space. It will close.
- 6. After expansion is complete, the appliance will stay in for a few months to act like a retainer.
